1. *Leader*- A person with influence.
2. *Honor*- a showing of unusual respect.
3. *Respect*- high or special regard.
4. *Culture*- the act of developing the intellectual and moral faculties especially by education.
5. *Subculture*- an ethnic, regional, economic, or social group exhibiting characteristic patterns of behavior sufficient to distinguish it from others within an embracing culture or society.
6. *Accountability*- an obligation or willingness to accept responsibility or to account for one's actions.
7. *Principle*- most important, consequential, or influential.
8. *Lifelong Learner*- Educating oneself continuing through life.
